At Rustington Hall we aim to provide residents with a secure, relaxed yet stimulating and homely environment with their care, comfort and wellbeing always our main focus. Rustington Hall is a Care Quality Commission (CQC) Dual-Registered Residential and Nursing Care Home, which can meet a wide range of personal needs for older people, within a supportive environment. We have an outstanding reputation and an excellent CQC regulatory history.

Our Registered Manager is supported by a Clinical Lead to lead a team of qualified and experienced nurses and carers. We maintain a generous ratio of staff to residents which, together with our Activity and Wellbeing team, ensures we meet everyone's individual needs including emotional, psychological and physical requirements.

Our housekeeping, catering, reception and maintenance teams ensure that non-clinical services are responsive and achieve high standards.

Rustington Hall provides a service that maximises choice and minimises unnecessary routine.





Rustington Hall Accommodation

All our rooms are dual-registered which ensures that, as our residents needs change, they can remain accommodated in the home allowing continuity of care.

A call-bell system is installed in every room and in all communal areas so that residents are able to obtain responsive assistance at all times.

The en-suite rooms are furnished and equipped to a high standard and offer free view televisions, internet access, direct dial telephones and modern profiling beds.

Rustington Hall boasts six 'state of the art' bathrooms with mobility assisted bathtubs and two wet rooms so that all our residents can bathe with dignity regardless of capabilities.

We encourage residents to bring in personal items to help them feel at home in their room.



Communal Living



Rustington Hall is proud of its newly refurbished modern lounge which leads onto a large, wheelchair-accessible, decking area. With the addition of an awning, our residents are able to enjoy relaxing and taking part in activities outside in the summer months.

We have a dedicated activities suite and a quiet lounge for reading or private visits. We also have a meditation/prayer room to facilitate spiritual and multi-faith needs.

Our communal grounds include secluded gardens, courtyard, terraces, verandas and a spacious wooden gazebo.

Dining at Rustington Hall




We understand that the whole dining experience is a crucial part of our resident's day and our Head Chef leads the catering team to provide high quality food, which is both nutritious and appetising.

Our activities and wellbeing team are on hand to entertain and connect with residents either through group activities or individual engagement.


Assistive technology is regularly used such as interactive projectors, tablets, and an accessible computer suite.
